1. Jump Starter with Built-In Air Compressor

4. Seasoned Firewood. Wood takes about 6 – 12 months to become dried, for home uses
5. Lamp Oil, Wicks, Lamps (First Choice: Buy CLEAR oil. If scarce, stockpile ANY!)
6. Vitamins
7. Guns, Ammunition, Pepper Spray, Knives, Clubs, Bats & Slingshots
8. Hand-can openers, hand eggbeaters, wire whisks, potato mashers
9. Honey/Syrups/white, brown sugar
10. Rice – Beans – Wheat
11. Vegetable Oil
12. Charcoal, Lighter Fluid (Will become scarce suddenly)
13. Water Containers (Urgent Item to obtain.) Note: food grade if for drinking
14. Mini Heater head (Propane)
15. Grain Grinder (Non-electric)
16. Propane Cylinders (Urgent: Definite shortages will occur)
17. Survival Guide Books
18. Mantles: Aladdin, Coleman, etc.
19. Baby Supplies: Diapers, formula. Ointment, powder
20. Washboards, Mop Bucket w/wringer (for Laundry)
21. Cook stoves (Propane, Coleman & Kerosene)
22. Coleman Fuel
23. Propane Cylinder refilling tool
24. Feminine Hygiene/Hair care/Skin products
25. Thermal underwear (Tops & Bottoms)
26. Bow saws, axes and hatchets, Wedges (also, honing oil)
27. Aluminum Foil Reg. & Heavy Duty
28. Gasoline Containers (Plastic & Metal)
29. Garbage Bags (Impossible To Have Too Many)
30. Toilet Paper, Kleenex, Paper Towels
31. Milk – Powdered & Condensed
32. Garden Seeds (Non-Hybrid)
