

REFUGE VERSES

Ruth 2:12 “May the LORD reward your work, and your wages be full from the LORD, the God of Israel, under whose wings you have come to seek **refuge**.”

2Sa 22:3 My God, my rock, in whom I take **refuge**, My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold and my **refuge**; My savior, You save me from violence.

2Sa 22:31 “As for God, His way is blameless; The word of the LORD is tested; He is a shield to all who take **refuge** in Him.

Psa 2:12 Do homage to the Son, that He not become angry, and you perish *in* the way, For His wrath may soon be kindled. How blessed are all who take **refuge** in Him!

Psa 5:11 But let all who take **refuge** in You be glad, Let them ever sing for joy; And may You shelter them, That those who love Your name may exult in You.

Psa 11:1 In the LORD I take **refuge**; How can you say to my soul, “Flee as a bird to your mountain;

Psa 16:1 Preserve me, O God, for I take **refuge** in You.

Psa 17:7 Wondrously show Your lovingkindness, O Savior of those who take **refuge** at Your right hand From those who rise up *against them*.

Psa 18:2 The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer, My God, my rock, in whom I take **refuge**; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

Psa 18:30 As for God, His way is blameless; The word of the LORD is tried; He is a shield to all who take **refuge** in Him.

Psa 25:20 Guard my soul and deliver me; Do not let me be ashamed, for I take **refuge** in You.

Psa 31:1 In You, O LORD, I have taken **refuge**; Let me never be ashamed; In Your righteousness deliver me.

Psa 31:19 How great is Your goodness, Which You have stored up for those who fear You, Which You have wrought for those who take **refuge** in You, Before the sons of men!

Psa 34:8 O taste and see that the LORD is good; How blessed is the man who takes **refuge** in Him!

Psa 34:22 The LORD redeems the soul of His servants, And none of those who take **refuge** in Him will be condemned.

Psa 36:7 How precious is Your lovingkindness, O God! And the children of men take **refuge** in the shadow of Your wings.

Psa 37:40 The LORD helps them and delivers them; He delivers them from the wicked and saves them, Because they take **refuge** in Him.

Psa 46:1 For the choir director. **A Psalm** of the sons of Korah, set to Alamoth. A Song. God is our **refuge** and strength, A very present help in trouble.

REFUGE VERSES

Psa 52:7 “Behold, the man who would not make God his **refuge**, But trusted in the abundance of his riches *And* was strong in his *evil* desire.”

Psa 55:8 “I would hasten to my place of **refuge** From the stormy wind *and* tempest.”

Psa 57:1 For the choir director; **set to** Al-tashheth. A Mikhtam of David, when he fled from Saul in the cave. Be gracious to me, O God, be gracious to me, For my soul takes **refuge** in You; And in the shadow of Your wings I will take **refuge** Until destruction passes by.

Psa 59:16 But as for me, I shall sing of Your strength; Yes, I shall joyfully sing of Your lovingkindness in the morning, For You have been my stronghold And a **refuge** in the day of my distress.

Psa 61:3 For You have been a **refuge** for me, A tower of strength against the enemy.

Psa 61:4 Let me dwell in Your tent forever; Let me take **refuge** in the shelter of Your wings. Selah.

Psa 62:7 On God my salvation and my glory *rest*; The rock of my strength, my **refuge** is in God.

Psa 62:8 Trust in Him at all times, O people; Pour out your heart before Him; God is a **refuge** for us. Selah.

Psa 64:10 The righteous man will be glad in the LORD and will take **refuge** in Him; And all the upright in heart will glory.

Psa 71:1 In You, O LORD, I have taken **refuge**; Let me never be ashamed.

Psa 71:7 I have become a marvel to many, For You are my strong **refuge**.

Psa 73:28 But as for me, the nearness of God is my good; I have made the Lord GOD my **refuge**, That I may tell of all Your works.

Psa 91:2 I will say to the LORD, “My **refuge** and my fortress, My God, in whom I trust!”

Psa 91:4 He will cover you with His pinions, And under His wings you may seek **refuge**; His faithfulness is a shield and bulwark.

Psa 91:9 For you have made the LORD, my **refuge**, *Even* the Most High, your dwelling place.

Psa 94:22 But the LORD has been my stronghold, And my God the rock of my **refuge**.

Psa 118:8 It is better to take **refuge** in the LORD Than to trust in man.

Psa 118:9 It is better to take **refuge** in the LORD Than to trust in princes.

Psa 141:8 For my eyes are toward You, O GOD, the Lord; In You I take **refuge**; do not leave me defenseless.

Psa 142:5 I cried out to You, O LORD; I said, “You are my **refuge**, My portion in the land of the living. Psa 143:9 Deliver me, O LORD, from my enemies; I take **refuge** in You.

REFUGE VERSES

Psa 144:2 My lovingkindness and my fortress, My stronghold and my deliverer, My shield and He in whom I take **refuge**, Who subdues my people under me.

Pro 14:26 In the fear of the LORD there is strong confidence, And his children will have **refuge**.

Pro 14:32 The wicked is thrust down by his wrongdoing, But the righteous has a **refuge** when he dies. Pro 30:5 Every word of God is tested; He is a shield to those who take **refuge** in Him.

Isa 4:6 There will be a shelter to *give* shade from the heat by day, and **refuge** and protection from the storm and the rain.

Isa 17:10 For you have forgotten the God of your salvation And have not remembered the rock of your **refuge**. Therefore you plant delightful plants And set them with vine slips of a strange *god*. Isa 25:4 For You have been a defense for the helpless, A defense for the needy in his distress, A **refuge** from the storm, a shade from the heat; For the breath of the ruthless Is like a *rain* storm *against* a wall.

Isa 28:15 Because you have said, “We have made a covenant with death, And with Sheol we have made a pact. The overwhelming scourge will not reach us when it passes by, For we have made falsehood our **refuge** and we have concealed ourselves with deception.”

Isa 30:2 Who proceed down to Egypt Without consulting Me, To take **refuge** in the safety of Pharaoh And to seek shelter in the shadow of Egypt!

Isa 57:13 “When you cry out, let your collection of *idols* deliver you. But the wind will carry all of them up, *And* a breath will take *them* away. But he who takes **refuge** in Me will inherit the land And will possess My holy mountain.”

Jer 16:19 O LORD, my strength and my stronghold, And my **refuge** in the day of distress, To You the nations will come From the ends of the earth and say, “Our fathers have inherited nothing but falsehood, Futility and things of no profit.”

Jer 17:17 Do not be a terror to me; You are my **refuge** in the day of disaster.

Joe 3:16 The LORD roars from Zion And utters His voice from Jerusalem, And the heavens and the earth tremble. But the LORD is a **refuge** for His people And a stronghold to the sons of Israel.

Nah 1:7 The LORD is good, A stronghold in the day of trouble, And He knows those who take **refuge** in Him.

Zep 3:12 “But I will leave among you A humble and lowly people, And they will take **refuge** in the name of the LORD.

Heb 6:18 so that by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have taken **refuge** would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us.
